Above and beyond...

n 1947 British library consultant Lionel McColvin, reflecting on the generally poor state of Australian libraries, asserted that 'better library services for Australia won't just happen ... the few must lead, must fight, must persist'. Because the relatively few did lead, did fight and did persist, at the end of the 20th century Australia now has library and information services in which, despite constraints on the achievement of their full potential, it can take considerable pride.

The ALIA Board of Directors is considering a 20th century honour roll, for permanent display in ALIA House, of people — professional and lay who have contributed significantly to library and information services and the profession during the 20th century. Below is my first attempt at a list
