# THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 23 of 1938.

## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Education Ordinance 1937.

**B**E it ordained by the Administrator of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1938*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Education Ordinance 1937* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1937-1938*.

2. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after the word "open," the words "the parent or guardian". Compulsory attendance.
