## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Interpretation Ordinance 1914.

B it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Interpretation* Short title and Ordinance 1919.
- (2.) The Interpretation Ordinance 1914, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Interpretation Ordinance 1914-1919.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the commencement fourteenth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
- 3. Section three of the *Interpretation Ordinance* 1914 is amended Definitions. by omitting from the definition of "The Minister" the words "Home Affairs" and inserting in their stead the words "Home and Territories".
