LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Practitioners Short title (Amendment) Ordinance 1976.*
- (2) The Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1975,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1976.
- 2. Section 6L of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1975 is Part to amended by omitting the word and figures "1 July 1976" and substituting the word and figures "1 January 1977".

- 3. Section 4 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (No. 4) 1975 Repeal is repealed.

On and after 1 January 1977, the Interpretation Ordinance Part ID 1967-1975 has effect in relation to the provisions of Part ID of the to be deemed Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1975, as amended by this 1 January Ordinance, as if those provisions had been repealed on that day by an 1977.
