

# TRESPASS ON COMMONWEALTH LANDS.

No. 2 of 1924.<sup>(a)</sup>

An Ordinance to amend the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1922-1923 and for other purposes.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910*, as follows :—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1924*.

(2.) The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1922*, as amended by the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1923*, the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1923* (No. 2) (No. 9 of 1923), and by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1922-1924*.

Repeal of Ordinance No. 10 of 1923.

2. The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1923* (No. 2) (No. 10 of 1923) is repealed.

Administration of Ordinance.

3. Section three of the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1922* is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) thereof the words “and to institute prosecutions for offences against this Ordinance”.
