AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF ANATOMY AGREEMENT.

Act No. 12 of 1933.

An Act to amend the *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1924-1931.*

[Assented to 24th July, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1933.*

(2.) The *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1924-1931* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1924-1933.*

2. After section three of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Agreements in relation to donations

“4. The Treasurer may enter into an Agreement in regard to any sum of money which may be contributed for any purpose connected with the Australian Institute of Anatomy, and may appoint one or more trustees to secure the accomplishment of the purpose.”

COMMERCE (TRADE DESCRIPTIONS).

No. 13 of 1933.

An Act to amend the *Commerce (Trade Descriptions) Act 1905-1930* and for other purposes.

[Assented to 24th July, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Commerce (Trade Descriptions) Act 1933.*

(2.) The *Commerce (Trade Descriptions) Act 1905-1930** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Commerce (Trade Descriptions) Act 1905-1933*.

2. The Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "Markets" wherever occurring and inserting in its stead the word "Commerce".

3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "officer" and inserting in its stead the following definition :—

Definitions.

" 'Officer' means an officer of Customs, and, in relation to exports, also includes an officer of the Department of Commerce, or any employee of the Department of Commerce, or any officer of a State engaged in the performance or execution for the Government of the Commonwealth of any work connected with the inspection or examination of goods in pursuance of this Act."

SUPPLY (No. 2) 1933-34.

No. 14 of 1933.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

[Assented to 10th October, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supply Act (No. 2) 1933-34*.

Short title.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four the sum of Two million seven hundred and ninety-nine thousand six hundred and twenty pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.
