JUDICIARY.

No. 5 of 1906.

An Act to amend the Judiciary Act 1903.

[Assented to 28th August, 1906.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Judiciary Act* 1906, and this Act and the *Judiciary Act* 1903 may together be cited as the *Judiciary Acts* 1903-1906.

Justices.

2. Section four of the *Judiciary Act* 1903 is amended by omitting the word "two" and inserting in lien thereof the word "four."

Admission of barristers and solicitors.

- 3. Section eighty-six of the *Judiciary Act* 1903 is amended by inserting after paragraph (g) the following paragraph:—
 - "(ga) Providing for the admission of persons to practise as barristers or solicitors in any Federal Court, and prescribing the conditions of and qualifications for admission, and continuance of the right to practise as aforesaid."

SUPPLY (No. 2).

No. 6 of 1906.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and seven.

[Assented to 29th August, 1906.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most-Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act (No. 2) 1906-7.

Short title.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards issue and making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the 2748,363. service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and seven the sum of Seven hundred and forty-eight thousand three hundred and sixty-three pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.

3. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under sum available e hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and set forth in the hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and services set forth in the said Schedule.

4. No moneys shall be expended under the authority of this Act Limit of period of expenditure. after the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and seven.

APPROPRIATION

(Works and Buildings).

No. 7 of 1906.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and seven for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 7th September, 1906.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Works and Short title. Buildings) Act 1906-7.
- 2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted application of £479,724.
