A BILL

To relieve the Council of the Municipality of Botany, on the transfer to that Council of certain works of drainage, of the obligation of that Council under section thirty-six of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924-1930, to make payments in respect of interest or of capital indebtedness; to amend the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Botany Stormwater Channel Act, 1934," and shall be construed with the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924-1930, as amended by subsequent Acts.

Botany Stormwater Channel.

2. On the Council of the Municipality of Botany being charged under section thirty-six of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924-1930, with the care, control and management of the service specified in the Schedule to this Act the provisions of paragraph (b) and of paragraph (c) of subsection one of that section shall not apply to the said Council in relation to such service.
