A BILL

To remove forfeitures incurred in consequence of certain dismissals from the railway and tramway services; to amend the Government Railways Act, 1912; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Government Railways (Forfeitures Removal) Act, 1919." Short title.

2. The following is added at the end of section one hundred and twenty-five of the Government Railways Act, 1912, and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the commencement of that Act:—

Removal of forfeitures under section 125.
"But if any officer after being so dismissed is employed as an officer in the service such forfeiture shall be voided provided that he repays in such manner and within such time as the Commissioners may determine the moneys (if any) received by him as or by way of refund of deductions made from his salary."
