

**GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS AND TRANSPORT
(AMENDMENT) ACT.**

Act No. 10, 1963.

An Act to make certain provisions with respect to officers of the Departments of Railways, Government Transport and Motor Transport; for these purposes to amend the Government Railways Act, 1912-1962, and the Transport Act, 1930-1962; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th March, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Government Railways and Transport (Amendment) Act, 1963".

(3) The Transport Act, 1930, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Transport Act, 1930-1963.

(5A) Where a person has been paid a gratuity under the provisions of this section or any sum in the nature of a gratuity for service as an officer and such person thereafter again becomes an officer, there shall for the purpose of calculating the number of weeks' salary or wages payable as further gratuity be excluded the number of weeks in respect of which such gratuity or sum in the nature of gratuity previously paid was calculated.
