## METROPOLITAN MEAT INDUSTRY (REMOVAL OF MEMBER) ACT.

## Act No. 44, 1927.

An Act to remove Aliek Dudley Kay, Esquire, George V, from his office as a member of the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board; to amend the Meat Industry Act, 1915; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Short title. Meat Industry (Removal of Member) Act, 1927."
- **2.** From the commencement of this Act Alick Removal of Dudley Kay, Esquire, shall cease to hold his office as a A. D. Kay, member of the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board, and from office, shall not be entitled to receive any further remuneration in respect of such office.
