No. 20, 1947. An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the services of the Year 1947-1948.

Preamble.

W HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to your Majesty the sum of Five millions four hundred and forty-one thousand six hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two millions two hundred and eighty-six thousand three hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Two millions four hundred and sixty-five thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

Out

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the No. 20, 1947. sum of Fifty-six thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Four hundred and seventy-nine thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Fifty-one thousand one hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of One hundred and three thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to His Majesty; Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by

No. 20, 1947. and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£2,286,300 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions two hundred and eighty-six thousand three hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1947-1948.

£2,465,500 may be issued out of the Government Railways Fund.

2. Out of the Government Railways Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions four hundred and sixty-five thousand five hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1947-1948.

£56,700 may be issued out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund.

3. Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Fifty-six thousand seven hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses

and other expenses of the Department of Road Trans- No. 20, 1947. port and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1947-1948.

4. Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General £479,000 Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or issued out towards making good the Supply so resolved to be of the Metgranted to His Majesty, the sum of Four hundred and Transport seventy-nine thousand pounds to be expended at the Trust rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year Fund. ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1947-1948.

No. 20, 1947. be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1947-1948.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

7. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, respectively.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

8. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Short title.

9. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 2). 1947."
