SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY (VARIATION OF AGREEMENTS) ACT.

Act No. 30, 1920.

George V, An Act to provide for the variation of certain agreements relating to the supply of electricity; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supply of Electricity (Variation of Agreements) Act, 1920."

Definition.

2. In this Act "company" means the Electric Light and Power Supply Corporation, Limited, or any person or firm or any other company to whom or to which this Act is made applicable by proclamation published under this Act.

Certain agreements may be varied.

3. Notwithstanding the terms of any agreement heretofore made by any company with the council of a municipality or shire, or with any person or corporation for the supply of electricity for any purpose such company

company shall be entitled to charge for electricity George V, supplied under any such agreement an amount to be No. 30. determined under the provisions of this Act.

4. The amount to be charged for electricity supplied Determination of any such agreement shall be determined under amount and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal chargeable. Council of Sydney Electric Lighting (Amendment) Act, 1920, so far as applicable, and the said provisions shall, mutatis mutandis, be deemed for this purpose to be incorporated with and to form part of this Act.

5. This Act shall apply to any person, firm, or com-Application pany which has agreed to supply electricity for any of Act. purpose and is specified in a proclamation made by the Governor under this Act and published in the Gazette.
