UNAUTHORIZED EXPENDITURE (1883) INDEMNITY.

Preamble.

An Act to indemnify the Colonial Treasurer the Officers of the Treasury and other Public Officers in respect of certain unauthorized advances and payments on the Public Account. [9th March, 1883.]

WHEREAS certain sums of money were advanced on the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to Public Officers for expenditure on the Public Account prior to the fifth day of January last without the authority of Parliament which said sums are shown by Schedule A hereto and amount to the sum of ninety-three thousand six hundred and ninety-five pounds eight shillings And whereas certain payments were made from the Consolidated Revenue Fund on the Public Account subsequent to the fifth day of January last also without the authority of Parliament for the Services and to the amounts set forth in Schedule B hereto which payments amount to the sum of one hundred and seventeen thousand eight hundred and eighty pounds nineteen shillings and three pence And whereas the respective sums so advanced and payments so made were necessary to carry on and maintain the Public Service And it is expedient to indemnify all persons concerned or engaged in the matter of such advances and payments

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Unauthorized Expenditure (1883) Indemnity.

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :---

The Colonial Treasurer and his Officers the Commander of Indemnityto Colonial the Training-ship "Wolverene" the Government Printer the Com- Treasurer and his Officers, &c. missioner for Railways and all persons whosever concerned or engaged in making the said advances or payments are hereby indemnified and held harmless for and in respect of the expenditure of the said sums of ninety-three thousand six hundred and ninety-five pounds eight shillings and one hundred and seventeen thousand eight hundred and cighty pounds nineteen shillings and three pence respectively. 2. This Act may be cited as the "Unauthorized Expenditure short title.
