Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to require a statutory body to include in its 1997–1998 and subsequent annual reports:

- (a) a statement setting out the statutory body's occupational health and safety performance during the reporting year, and
- (b) such related statistical information for the reporting year as is determined by the Secretary of the Treasury.

This Regulation is made under the *Annual Reports (Statutory Bodies) Act* 1984, including sections 9 and 17 (the general regulation-making power).

Insert at the end of the Schedule:

Occupational health and safety

In the case of a statutory body's annual report for its 1997–98 financial year, and any subsequent financial year:

- (a) a statement setting out the statutory body's occupational health and safety performance during the reporting year (including details of work-related injuries, work-related illnesses and prosecutions under the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983), and
- (b) statistical information for the reporting year of such kind, and set out in such form, as is determined by the Secretary of the Treasury.
