CHIROPRACTORS AND OSTEOPATHS ACT 1991— REGULATION

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 28 February 1992.

Amendments

- **2.** The Chiropractors and Osteopaths Regulation 1991 is amended:
- (a) by omitting from clause 7 (1) the matter "\$140" and by inserting instead the matter "\$145";
- (b) by omitting from clause 9 (2) the matter "\$16" and by inserting instead the matter "\$20";
- (c) by omitting from clause 12 (2) the matter "\$6" and by inserting instead the matter "\$10";
- (d) by omitting from clause 13 (b) the matter "\$90" and by inserting instead the matter "\$100";
- (e) by omitting from clause 14 (1) the matter "\$180" and by inserting instead the matter "\$200".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Regulation 1991 so as to increase certain fees relating to:

- (a) the application for registration as a chiropractor or an osteopath or a chiropractor and osteopath; and
- (b) the issue of a duplicate certificate of registration as a practitioner, or a copy of an extract from one of the registers relating to chiropractors or osteopaths or chiropractors and osteopaths; and
- (c) the annual roll fee payable by practitioners; and
- (d) the restoration of a practitioner's name to one of the registers.
