EXPLANATORY NOTE

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to extend by 30 minutes the time that the Land Titles Office is open to persons conducting public searches of registers kept under the Conveyancing Act 1919; and
- (b) to increase certain fees payable to the Registrar-General under the Act.

This Regulation is made under the Conveyancing Act 1919, including sections 64, 195J, 199 and 202 (the general regulation—making power, in particular, section 202 (1) (d)).
