The Maritime Services Board of New South Wales, in pursuance of the Commercial Vessels Act 1979, hereby makes the following Regulation:

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 20 August 1993.

Amendment

2. The Commercial Vessels (Load Lines) Regulation 1986 is amended by omitting items 1,2,3 and 4 from Schedule 2 and by inserting instead the following items:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Commercial Vessels (Load Lines) Regulation 1986 to increase fees for the:

- (a) initial survey and issue of load line certificates; and
- (b) initial survey and issue of load line exemption certificates; and
- (c) periodic survey of load lines; and
- (d) periodic inspection of load lines.

This Regulation is made under the Commercial Vessels Act 1979, including section 38.
