The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Prisons Act 1952 contained in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1991 which change the names of the positions of Director-General and Deputy Director-General of Corrective Services to Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner of Corrective Services respectively.
