## Regulations under the Hospital Advisory Boards Ordinance

**I** JOHN NORMAN NELSON, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, having received the advice of the Administrator's Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the Hospital Advisory Boards Ordinance.

## HOSPITAL ADVISORY BOARDS (FEES AND ALLOWANCES) REGULATION

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hospital Advisory Boards Citation (Fees and Allowances) Regulations.

2. These Regulations do not apply to a member of a board who is— Application

(a) a Magistrate within the meaning of the Justices Ordinance; or

- (b) an officer or employee of—
  - (i) the Public Service of the Commonwealth; or
  - (ii) the Public Service of the Territory.

**3.** A member of a board shall be paid in respect of each day or part Fees of a day on which he attends a meeting of the board or is otherwise engaged, at the direction of the board, on business of the board—

- (a) in the case of a Chairman of the board a fee of 20 dollars; and
- (b) in the case of another member a fee of 15 dollars.

4. Where a member of a board is necessarily absent overnight from his Allowances place of residence in order to attend a meeting of the board or to perform any business of the board on which he is engaged at the direction of the board—

(a) travelling allowance at the rate of One dollar 50 cents per day is payable to him in respect of the period of absence;

- (b) he shall be reimburged the cost of his accommodation overnight reasonably incurred; and
- (c) he shall be reimbursed the transport expenses reasonably incurred in respect of that attendance or performance of that business.

One payment only in respect of a day 5. Where a member of a board to whom these Regulations apply attends a meeting of the board and is also on the same day engaged on other business of the board at the direction of the board, the member is only entitled to be paid once under these Regulations in respect of that attendance and engagement on that day.
