AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS

1.(1) Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by Salaries and allowances omitting sub-regulation (1) and substituting the following sub-regulation:

"(1) Except as provided by this section, an officer, other than an officer of the Department of the Legislative Council, shall be paid a salary at such annual rate as is specified in the following table within the limits of the scale of rates of annual salary fixed in respect of his office:

- (2) Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by inserting after sub-regulation (1A) the following sub-regulations:
 - "(1B) A Typist Grade 1 shall be paid an allowance—
 - (a) at the rate of \$152 per annum if she is not entitled to an allowance under paragraph (b) and she has passed a test in typing at the rate of 50 words per minute and in typing letters and documents with due regard to punctuation and form; or

(b) at the rate per annum specified in the second column of the table in this paragraph in relation to the highest speed in words per minute specified in the first column of that table at which she has passed a test in writing and correctly transcribing that shorthand.

- "(1c) A Steno-Secretary Grade 2 shall, if she has passed a test in writing and correctly writing and transcribing shorthand at the rate of 140 words per minute, be paid an allowance at the rate equal to the difference between the rate at which salary is payable to her and \$6375 per annum.".
- (3) Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (5).

Certain officers not entitled to overtime 2. Regulation 51 (1A) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting "and Deputy Clerk of the Legislative Council" and substituting ", Deputy Clerk of the Legislative Council and Comptroller, Prisons Branch".

Repeal of regulations 63, 64 and 65 3. Regulations 63, 64 and 65 of the Public Service Regulations are repealed.

Repeal of regulations 93A, 94, 95 and 96 4. Regulations 93A, 94, 95 and 96 of the Public Service Regulations are repealed.
