Regulations under the Supply of Services Ordinance 1952-1965

AMENDMENTS OF THE SEWERAGE REGULATIONS†

- 1. Regulation 239 of the Sewerage Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:-
- "239.—(1.) Subject to these Regulations, a sewerage charge is imposed for Sewerage charges a yearly period commencing on the first day of July in each year in respect of each parcel of land that is or is included in land declared under regulation 251 to be land which is or will be served by a sewer.

- "(2.) The amount of the sewerage charge is—
 - (a) in a case where there are more than two sanitary fixtures on the land—an amount equal to the sum of Thirty dollars and an amount calculated at the rate of Twelve dollars for each sanitary fixture on the land in excess of two sanitary fixtures; or
 - (b) in any other case—Thirty dollars.
- "(3.) For the purposes of this regulation—
 - (a) 'sanitary fixture' means a water closet or urinal that is flushed by a flushing cistern or flush valve;
 - (b) a urinal stall for use by one person at a time, whether or not grouped as a unit with other urinal stalls, shall be deemed to be one sanitary fixture; and
 - (c) each complete two feet of a continuous trough for use as a urinal shall be deemed to be one sanitary fixture.".
- 2. Regulation 240 of the Sewerage Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.).
- 3. The amendments of the Sewerage Regulations made by these Regulations apply to and in relation to the financial year that commenced on the first day of July, 1972, and each subsequent financial year.
