BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title
and con-
struction.

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Charters Towers Water Board Act Amendment Act of 1918*," and shall be read as one with *"*The Charters Towers Water Board Act of 1906*."

2. (1.) *"*The Charters Towers Water Board Act of 1906*" is amended as follows :—

In section two, in the definition of "Water Board," after the words "Charters Towers," the words "as

constituted for the time being under the Principal Act" are inserted; also, the definitions of "Local Authorities Act" and "Ratepayer" are repealed.

Section three is repealed, and from and after the constitution of a Water Board under **"The Water Authorities Act of 1891,"* and the election or other appointment of the first members of such Board, the Water Board constituted by the said section three shall be abolished.

In section four the words "Shire of Queenton" are repealed, and the words "City of Charters Towers" are inserted in lieu thereof.

(2.) Upon the constitution under **"The Water Authorities Act of 1891"* of a Water Board for the Water Area of Charters Towers, and upon the election or other appointment of the first members of such Water Board, all the lands, works, property, moneys, rights, powers, authorities, duties, liabilities, and obligations of the Water Board hereby abolished shall vest in and be imposed upon the new Water Board.

Transfer of assets and liabilities from old to new Board.

All water rates which, having accrued due to the Water Board hereby abolished, are at the time of the election or other appointment of the first members of the new Water Board due or payable to or leviable by or for the Water Board hereby abolished, shall be and continue to be so due, payable, and leviable, and may and shall be paid to, and received, levied, and recovered by, the new Water Board; and all penalties and forfeitures then incurred may and shall be enforced by such new Water Board.

And all rights, liabilities, contracts, and engagements existing, and all actions, suits, and proceedings pending, at the time of the election or other appointment of the first members of the new Water Board, by or against the Water Board hereby abolished, shall be transferred to and vested in, and may be enforced, carried on, and prosecuted by or against, the new Water Board; and no such action, suit, or proceeding shall abate, or be discontinued or prejudicially affected, by anything in this Act contained.
