An Act to Amend "The Governor's Salary Acts, 1872 to 1955," in a certain particular.

[RESERVED: HER MAJESTY'S ASSENT PROCLAIMED:

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "*The Governor's Salary Acts Amendment Act of 1956.*"

Principal Act.

(2.) *"*The Governor's Salary Acts, 1872 to 1955,*" are in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Collective title.

The Principal Act and this Act may be collectively cited as "*The Governor's Salary Acts, 1872 to 1956.*"

Repeal of and new s. 4A.

2. Section 4A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is inserted in lieu of that repealed section:—

Amount of salary.

"[4A.] The salary of the Governor of Queensland shall be, and it is hereby declared always was to be, on and after the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, at the rate of five thousand three hundred and twenty-five pounds per annum.

Such salary shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund which is hereby appropriated accordingly."
