as a means of ingress or egress for all persons in the mine on any working day and as an adequate means of egress in case of emergency, and until he has certified to that effect in the record book.

(6.) Where there are a downcast shaft and upcast shaft to the same seam both such shafts shall be provided with apparatus for raising and lowering persons, and every person employed in the mine shall on giving reasonable notice have the option of using the downcast shaft."

**An Act to Amend "The Mines Regulation Acts, 1910 to 1916" (as amended by subsequent Acts) in certain particulars.**

[ASSENTED TO 10TH OCTOBER, 1938.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "*The Mines Regulation Acts Amendment Act of 1938.*"

*Mines Regulation Acts Amendment Act.**Amendments of the Principal Act.*

2. The definition of "Inspector" in section four of the Principal Act is amended by adding thereto the following words, namely:—"the term also includes an electrical inspector appointed under this Act." Amendment of s. 4.

3. Section six of the Principal Act is amended, as follows:— Amendment of s. 6.

(a) The words "including electrical inspectors" are added to the first paragraph of the said section.

(b) The following new paragraph is inserted after the second paragraph of the said section, namely:—

"Provided that it shall not be necessary for an electrical inspector to hold a first-class certificate as a mine manager, but any such person so appointed shall be the holder of a degree in electrical engineering from the University of Queensland or the holder of a qualification from any educational body recognised by the Department of Mines."
