**E** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and construction.

1. This Act may be cited as "The Supreme Court Acts Amendment Act of 1950," and shall be read as one with †" The Supreme Court Acts, 1861 to 1949."

Collective title.

†" The Supreme Court Acts, 1861 to 1949," and this Act may collectively be cited as "The Supreme Court Acts. 1861 to 1950."

Salaries of Judges of the Supreme Court.

- 2. (1.) The salary of the Chief Justice of Queensland shall be at the rate of three thousand three hundred and fifty pounds per annum.
- (2.) The salaries of the Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court shall be at the rate of three thousand one hundred pounds per annum.
