An Act to Amend "The South Johnstone, Gin Gin, 9 GRO. VI. No. 29.

North Eton, and Mount Bauple Sugar THE SOUTH JOHNSTONE, Works Acts, 1927 to 1937," in certain North Eton, and Mount Bauple Sugar Johnstone, Gin Gin, North Eton, North Eton, And Mount Bauple Sugar Works Acts.

[Assented to 6th December, 1945.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "The South Short title Johnstone, Gin Gin, North Eton, and Mount Bauple Sugar and construction." Works Acts Amendment Act of 1945," and shall be read construction. as one with *" The South Johnstone, Gin Gin, North Eton, and Mount Bauple Sugar Works Acts, 1927 to 1937," herein collectively referred to as the Principal Act.
- (2.) The Principal Act and this Act may collectively collective be cited as "The South Johnstone, Gin Gin, North Eton, title. and Mount Bauple Sugar Works Acts, 1927 to 1945."

Amendments of the Principal Act.

- 2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended as Amendment follows:—
 - (i.) Paragraph (f) is repealed.
- (ii.) Paragraph (h) is repealed and a new paragraph (h) is inserted in lieu thereof, namely:—
- "(h) When the whole of the liability to the Transfer by Treasurer with interest thereon, of the association referred to Corporation to in this section four shall have been liquidated as association. prescribed by this Act, it shall be lawful for the Corporation to transfer and the Corporation shall transfer to such association all the right, title and interest of the Corporation in the South Johnstone Sugar Works. Upon the execution of such transfer such sugar works shall be divested from the Corporation and shall vest in such association, and by virtue of this Act all the liabilities and obligations of the Corporation in respect of or otherwise in relation to such sugar works shall be borne and discharged by such association."

Amendment of s. 6 (2).

- 3. Section six of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
- (i.) Subsection two is amended by repealing the second and third paragraphs thereof, beginning with the word "Moreover" and ending with the words "the Treasurer."
- (ii.) In the fourth paragraph of the said subsection two, the words "the South Johnstone Co-operative Sugar Milling Association Limited" are inserted after the words "Moreover, in the case of default by" occurring at the commencement of the said paragraph.
- (iii.) In the fifth paragraph of the said subsection the words "such three last-mentioned associations" are repealed and the words "the said associations" are inserted in lieu thereof.

Operation of amend-ments.

4. The amendments made in the Principal Act by this Act shall be deemed to have been made therein at the passing of *" The South Johnstone, Gin Gin, North Eton, and Mount Bauple Sugar Works Act of 1927," and shall have retrospective operation accordingly.

Declaration as to nonapplication of system of cane credits.

- 5. The provisions of †" The Sugar Works Act of 1911" with respect to cane credits as defined in that Act shall not apply, and it is hereby declared that such provisions never applied, to or in respect of—
 - (i.) The South Johnstone Sugar Works; or
 - (ii.) Any other sugar works of which the management and control has been transferred from the Corporation of the Treasurer of Queensland constituted by ‡" The Sugar Works Guarantee Acts Amendment Act of 1908," to a primary producers' co-operative association registered under §" The Primary Producers' Co-operative Associations Acts, 1923 to 1934,"

and no cane credit shall under any circumstances whatsoever be or be deemed ever to have been established or come or be deemed ever to have come into possession for or by any person whomsoever in respect of any such sugar works.
