An Act to Increase the Limit of the Borrowing Powers of the Townsville Harbour Board, under "The Townsville Harbour Board Act, 1895," to £350,000.

[Assented to 24th November, 1910.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and construction of Act.

1. This Act may be cited as "The Townsville Harbour Board Acts Amendment Act of 1910," and shall be read as one with "The Townsville Harbour Board Act, 1895," and "The Townsville Harbour Board Act, 1895, Amendment Act of 1897," and may be cited together with those Acts as "The Townsville Harbour Board Acts, 1895 to 1910."

Increase of limit of borrowing powers to £350,000.

2. In section twenty-six of "The Townsville Harbour Board Act, 1895," the words "Two hundred and fifty thousand pounds", where they twice occur, are repealed, and the words "Three hundred and fifty thousand pounds" are respectively inserted in lieu thereof.
