An Act to amend the Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1946.

[Assented to 3rd November, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Friendly Societies short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1949".
- (2) The Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1949 ".

- (3) The Friendly Societies Act, 1919-1946, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. Section 7 of the principal Act (as amended by section 2 Amendment of the Friendly Societies Act Amendment Act. 1946) is s. 7 of the Friendly Societies Act Amendment Act, 1946) is amended-

- (a) by adding at the end of subsection (1) thereof the following paragraphs:-
 - VI. For establishing a fund for the purpose of providing superannuation or retiring benefits for officers of the society or branch who are permanently employed by the society or branch:
 - VII. For the payment of the expenses of management which are reasonably necessary for the purposes of the society or branch.

 - (b) by striking out the word "two" in the fifth line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "five";
 - (c) by striking out the word "three" in the proviso to subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "five";
 - (d) by striking out the word "three" in the last line of subsection (3) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "five".

Amendment of third schedule of principal Act—

3. The third schedule to the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:—

Rules.

18. Provisions providing for the payment of the expenses of management of the society or branch.
