An Act to amend the Prices Act, 1948-1966, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 18th August, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prices Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1966".
- (2) The Prices Act, 1948-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prices Act, 1948-1966".
- (3) The Prices Act, 1948-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 50— Offences.

- 3. Subsection (3) of section 50 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the words "one hundred pounds" in paragraph (a) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "two hundred dollars";

and

(b) by striking out the words "five hundred pounds" in paragraph (b) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand dollars".

4. Section 51 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "one hundred pounds" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "two hundred dollars".

Amendment of principal Act, 5.51—
Regulations.

5. Section 53 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "sixty-seven" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "sixty-eight".

Amendment of principal Act, a. 58—
Duration of Act.
