**An Act to amend the Police Offences Act, 1953-1976.**

*[Assented to 16th December, 1976]*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Offences Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1976".

(2) The Police Offences Act, 1953-1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Offences Act, 1953-1976".

**Commencement.**

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

**Repeal of s. 9 of principal Act.**

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is repealed.

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 9a—  
Consumption and sale of methylated spirits**

4. Section 9a of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (1), (2) and (3).
