

ANNO VICESIMO OCTAVO ET VICESIMO NONO VICTORIÆ REGINÆ. A.D. 1865.

No. 10.

An Act further to amend an Act, No. 20 of 22nd Victoria, intituled "An Act for an Assessment on Stock, and for other purposes therein mentioned."

[Assented to, 4th August, 1865.]

WHEREAS by an Act No. 20 of 1858 it was enacted that on Preamble. application from the lessee, twelve months before the expiration of any lease of the Waste Lands of the Crown for pastoral purposes, the annual value of the land comprised in such lease should be determined as in the said Act mentioned, and that such valuation, on being confirmed by the Governor in Executive Council, should be forthwith published in the South Australian Government Gazette, for general information; and it was further enacted that the person beneficially interested in any such lease at the expiration thereof should be also entitled to a renewed lease of the lands comprised therein, for the further term of five years, at the annual rent to be determined as aforesaid; and in case he should, within three months after notice of a valuation having been so fixed, as aforesaid, decline to accept a renewed lease of such land at such rent, the lands included in such lease should be dealt with and disposed of in accordance with any laws or regulations affecting the leasing of the Waste Lands of the Crown for the time being in force: And whereas the several lessees, whose names appear in the Schedule hereto, are respectively lessees of Waste Lands of the Crown, the number of whose respective leases appear against the name of each lessee in such Schedule, and such persons have by inadvertence neglected to make application twelve months before the expiration of their respective leases, and it is expedient to rectify such mistake-Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent

of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

Certain lessees who have neglected to accept renewed leases, to be allowed to accept same.

1. The several persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto, and who are lessees of the Waste Lands of the Crown of the lands included in the lease, the respective number of which lease also appears in such Schedule against the name of each lessee, shall be entitled to a renewed lease of such lands, at a valuation to be made by some person or persons appointed by the Governor, in all respects as if they had duly applied to have the annual value thereof for five years determined as in the said Act No. 20 of 1858 mentioned.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
