### The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

#### Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the South Australian Health Commission (Direction of Hospitals and Health Centres) Amendment Act 2000.
- (2) The South Australian Health Commission Act 1976 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

#### Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

#### Insertion of Division 1A of Part 3

3. The following Division is inserted after section 29B of the principal Act:

# **DIVISION 1A—POWER OF DIRECTION**

# Incorporated hospital to be subject to direction

29C. (1) An incorporated hospital is subject to direction by the Minister.

- (2) A direction cannot be given-
- (a) so as to affect clinical decisions relating to the treatment of any particular patient; or
- (b) for the sale or disposal of land, buildings or equipment that is not held by the Crown; or
- (c) relating to the employment of a particular person or the assignment, transfer, remuneration, discipline or termination of a particular employee.
- (3) A direction under this section must be given in writing and must be published in the Gazette.
- (4) Particulars of directions given under this section must be included in the hospital's annual report.

# Insertion of Division 1A of Part 4

4. The following Division is inserted after section 50B of the principal Act:

#### DIVISION 1A—POWER OF DIRECTION

# Incorporated health centre to be subject to direction

**50C.** (1) An incorporated health centre is subject to direction by the Minister.

- (2) A direction cannot be given—
- (a) so as to affect clinical decisions relating to the treatment of any particular patient; or

- (b) for the sale or disposal of land, buildings or equipment that is not held by the Crown; or
- relating to the employment of a particular person or the assignment, transfer, remuneration, discipline or termination of a particular employee.
- (3) A direction under this section must be given in writing and must be published in the Gazette.
- (4) Particulars of directions given under this section must be included in the health centre's annual report.
