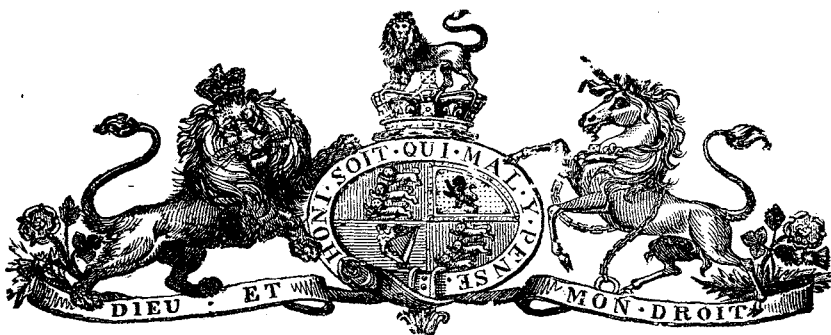

AN ACT Supplementary to the Act for appropriating a Sum arising from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Year 1898. A.D. 1898.

[29 October, 1898.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, for the service of the Year 1898, the sum of Three hundred Pounds, as compensation to Mr. *A. T. Morrison*, late Government Surveyor, for loss of office. Appropriation.

**2** The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum to the said Mr. *A. T. Morrison* upon such day as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, orders and directs; and the payment so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the said Colony. Money payable by Warrant of Governor.

**3** The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for such sum of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipt of the said Mr. *A. T. Morrison* shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sum, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. Credit to be given to the Treasurer in Accounts.
