

AN ACT to appropriate a certain Sum from the General Revenue to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Year 1866.

[29 September, 1865.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the General Revenue of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the purpose hereinafter mentioned, any sum of money not exceeding in amount the sum of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

Pensions, Retired Allowances, &c.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum to such person for the purpose hereinbefore mentioned, upon such day as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, orders and directs; and the payment so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the General Revenue.

Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor.

Credit to be given

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sum of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid ; and the receipt of the person to whom the same is so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for the sum as is therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
