

AN ACT to authorise a Loan of £5000 to A.D. 1897.
the Marine Board of *Launceston*, in accord-
ance with the provisions of "The Local
Public Works Loans Act, 1890."

[24 *December*, 1897.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," the sum of £5000 as a Loan to the Marine Board of *Launceston* for Harbour Improvements; and such moneys shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Loan may be granted to *Launceston* Marine Board.
