

AN ACT to amend "An Act to authorise the Loan of certain Sums of Money to the Municipality of Glenorchy, and for other purposes." [8 *January*, 1915.]

**W**HEREAS it is desirable to amend "An Act to authorise the Loan of certain Sums of Money to the Municipality of Glenorchy, and for other purposes" (which Act is hereinafter referred to as "The Principal Act"), by increasing the amount which may be granted by the Governor as a loan to the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Glenorchy for the purposes of the Principal Act from Seven thousand Pounds to Twelve thousand Pounds:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** Section Three of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting from the Fourth line thereof the words "Seven thousand," and substituting therefor the words "Twelve thousand."

Amendment of  
Section 4 of the  
Principal Act.

**2** Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting from the Tenth and Eleventh lines thereof the words "Seven thousand," and substituting therefor the words "Twelve thousand."
