

AN ACT to authorise the Marine Board of *Hobart* to pay certain Gratuities. A.D. 1899.
[1 *December*, 1899.]

WHEREAS the Marine Board of *Hobart* (hereinafter referred to as "the said Board"), has paid a gratuity to the Widow of Captain *James Riddle*, deceased, formerly an Officer of the said Board : PREAMBLE.

And whereas the said Board desires to pay a Gratuity to the Widow of Captain *William Harrison*, deceased, also formerly an Officer of the said Board :

And whereas doubts have arisen as to the power of the said Board, under the existing Acts, to pay any sum of money as a Gratuity to the Widows of such deceased Officers :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 The payment by the said Board of the sum of One hundred and thirty-seven Pounds Ten Shillings to the Widow of the said Captain *James Riddle*, deceased, is hereby authorised. Payment to Widow of *Captain Riddle*.

2 It shall be lawful for the said Board, out of the funds at its disposal, to pay the sum of Seventy-five Pounds as a gratuity to the Widow of the said Captain *William Harrison*, deceased. Payment to Widow of *Captain Harrison*.
