

AN ACT to authorise the Marine Board of A.D. 1900.

Launceston to pay a certain Gratuity.

[22 September, 1900.]

WHEREAS the Marine Board of Launceston (hereinafter referred PREAMBLE. to as "the said Board"), has paid a gratuity to the Widow of George William Smith, deceased, formerly an officer of the said Board:

And whereas doubts have arisen as to the power of the said Board, under the existing Acts, to pay any sum of money as a Gratuity to the Widow of such deceased officer:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The payment by the said Board of the sum of Twelve Pounds to the Widow of the said George William Smith, deceased, is hereby authorised.
