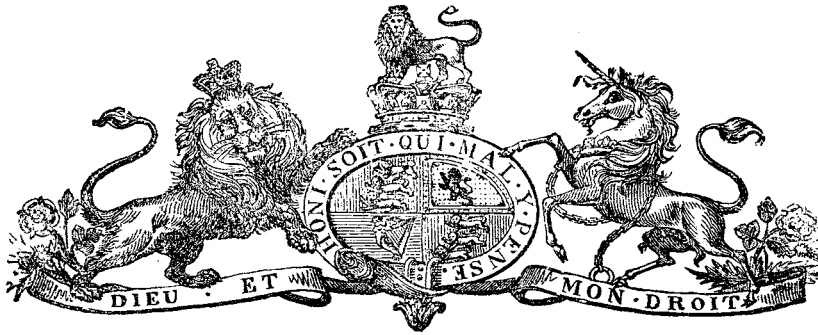

AN ACT to continue "The Diseased Animals Importation Prevention Act." A.D. 1885.
[7 September, 1885.]

WHEREAS "The Diseased Animals Importation Prevention Act" will expire on the Thirty-first day of *December*, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five: And whereas it is expedient to provide for the continuance of the said Act: PREAMBLE.
47 Vict. No. 2.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 "The Diseased Animals Importation Prevention Act" shall be and the same is hereby continued in full force and effect until the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1886: Provided nevertheless, all proceedings, civil or criminal, by the said Act authorised to be taken may be commenced or prosecuted after the said Thirty-first day of *December*, 1886. 47 Vict.
