

AN ACT to extend and amend the Provisions of the Act of Council of the 6th William 4th, [23 September, 1859.]

E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Provisions of Sections 12 and 13 of the Act of Council of the Provisions of 6th William 4th, No. 17, shall apply and extend to Pigs, and to the Sections 12 and 13 carcasses and portions of the carcasses of Pigs.

2 In case of the non-payment of the penalty imposed for any offence In default of payagainst Sections 12 and 13 of the said recited Act, or against this Act, ment of penalty, the person offending shall be liable to be imprisoned, with or without hard labour, for any term not exceeding Twelve Months, unless such imprisonment. hard labour, for any term not exceeding Twelve Months, unless such penalty and all costs are sooner paid.

3 This Act and the said recited Act shall be read and construed Acts to be read together. together as one and the same Act.
