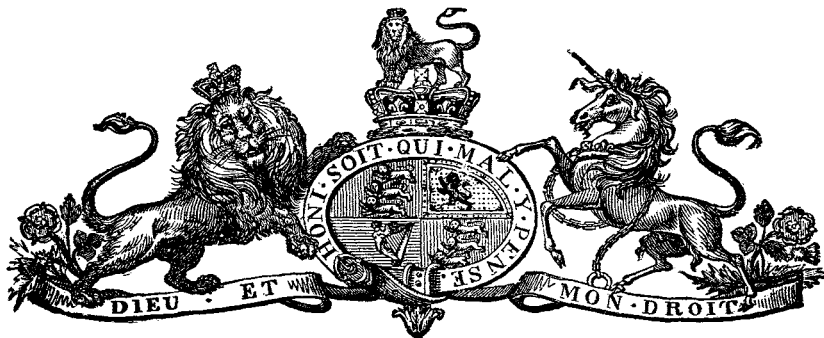

AN ACT to extend and amend the Provisions of  
the Act of Council of the 6th *William* 4th,  
No. 17. [23 September, 1859.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of  
Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

| <p><b>1</b> The Provisions of Sections 12 and 13 of the Act of Council of the 6th <i>William</i> 4th, No. 17, shall apply and extend to Pigs, and to the carcasses and portions of the carcasses of Pigs.</p> <p><b>2</b> In case of the non-payment of the penalty imposed for any offence against Sections 12 and 13 of the said recited Act, or against this Act, the person offending shall be liable to be imprisoned, with or without hard labour, for any term not exceeding Twelve Months, unless such penalty and all costs are sooner paid.</p> <p><b>3</b> This Act and the said recited Act shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.</p> | <p>Provisions of Sections 12 and 13 of 6 W. 4, No. 17, extended to Pigs.</p> <p>In default of payment of penalty, offender liable to imprisonment.</p> <p>Acts to be read together.</p> |
