

AN ACT to enable the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Fingal* to pay a Gratuity in a certain case, and for other purposes. [30 November, 1906.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of *Fingal* may grant to the widow of their late Council Clerk, *Henry Lyne*, deceased, any gratuity which to the Council may seem fit, in recognition of his faithful services; and they may pay the same out of the Municipal Fund of the Municipality. Any payment already made by the Council, whether to the said *Henry Lyne* in his lifetime, or to his widow, as or on account of a gratuity shall be deemed to have been duly authorised by law, and be valid.

*Fingal* Municipal Council may grant Gratuity to their late Council Clerk, *Henry Lyne*, deceased, or his widow.
