

AN ACT to fix the Salaries of the Responsible A.D. 1882. Ministers of the Crown. [21 August, 1882.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to increase and fix the Salaries of the PREAMBLE. Responsible Ministers of the Crown:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 From and after the Thirty-first day of December, 1882, there shall Sums to be be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, as the payable to persons Salaries of the persons holding the offices named in the Schedule, holding certain offices. the sums set opposite such offices in the said Schedule; and the provisions of Section Thirty of The Constitutional Act shall be 18 Vict. No. 17. applicable in respect of such sums in the same manner as if they were inserted in the Schedule B. of that Act instead of the sums therein specified as Salaries in respect of certain of the said offices.

2 The Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 30th Victoria, Repeal. No. 9, and so much of the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 30 Vict. No. 9. 33rd Victoria, No. 4, as provides that the person filling the Office of 33 Vict. No. 4. Minister of Lands and Works shall receive a Salary of Seven hundred Pounds per annum, shall be repealed from and after the Thirty-first day of December, 1882; but such repeal shall not affect the payment of any sum of money payable thereunder before such repeal takes effect.

Any person who shall, in conjunction with any Ministerial Office mentioned in the Schedule, hold the position of Premier, shall be entitled to receive an additional £200 per annum during the time he continues to hold such position of Premier in conjunction with a Ministerial Office.
