

AN ACT to make provision for the Purchase of Land required in connection with the erection of New Post and Telegraph Offices, *Hobart*. [7 May, 1900.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to purchase certain Land required in connection with the erection of New Post and Telegraph Offices at *Hobart* at a cost not exceeding Six thousand five hundred Pounds:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to purchase and acquire for and on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen certain Land in *Elizabeth-street, Hobart*, at a sum not exceeding Six thousand five hundred Pounds; and such sum of money shall be defrayed out of moneys to be hereafter provided by Parliament.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works for and on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen to sell or exchange any portion of the Land acquired under this Act for other land situate near such Land: Provided that the Land so sold or exchanged shall not exceed Seven perches.
