AN ACT to provide for the Construction of Telegraph Lines and the Extension of Telephonic Communication.

A.D. 1886.

[8 December, 1886.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand Five hundred Pounds, in and towards the construction of Telegraph Lines, under *The Electric Telegraph Act*, and the extension of Telephonic communication, under "*The Telephone Act, 1882.*"
