ANALYSIS

1. Short title and citation.
2. Application of Principal Act to 1975 season.

AN ACT to make provision for the application with modification of the Apple Industry (Assistance) Act 1974 to apples produced in the 1975 season.

[1 October 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Apple Industry (Assistance) Act 1975*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Apple Industry (Assistance) Act 1974* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Application of
Principal Act
to 1975 season.

2 The Principal Act has effect in respect of the apples produced during the period of 12 months ending on 30th June 1975 as if that period were the period of 12 months referred to in section 3 of that Act and as if—

- (a) in section 4 of that Act, for the references to \$2 there were substituted references to 80 cents;
- (b) in subsection (4) of that section, for the number “2 000 000” (wherever occurring) there were substituted the number “2 140 000” in each case; and
- (c) in section 6 (1) (b) of that Act for the reference to 30th June 1974 there were substituted a reference to 30th June 1975.
