**AN ACT to amend the Constitution Act 1934.**

[30 November 1977]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—(1)** This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Assembly Divisions) Act 1977*. Short title and citation.

**(2)** The *Constitution Act 1934*\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Schedule IV to the Principal Act is repealed and the following schedule is substituted therefor:—

## “ SCHEDULE IV

“(Section 27)

### “ DESCRIPTIONS AND BOUNDARIES OF ASSEMBLY DIVISIONS

#### “ *Bass*

“ Commencing at the confluence of the Tamar River with Bass Strait, thence via that river and Cormiston Creek to its intersection with the H.E.C. transmission line, by that line in a general south-easterly, southerly, south-westerly and easterly direction to its western intersection with Kings Meadows Rivulet, then south-easterly to the source of Jinglers Creek, via that creek and the North Esk River, to its source, to Mt Victoria, to the junction of Lottah Road with the Tasman Highway at Little Plain, to Murdoch's Hill and to the source of Ansons River, via that river to its confluence with the Tasman Sea, thence northerly and westerly along the coast to the point of commencement.

“ Including also, all islands adjacent to that coast, the Furneaux Group, Kent Group, Hogan Group and Curtis Group of Islands in Bass Strait.

#### “ *Braddon*

“ Commencing at the confluence of the Davey River with the Southern Ocean, then northerly and easterly along the coast to the Mersey Bluff lighthouse, then via Bluff Road, William Street, Middle Road and the Bass Highway to the Don River, via the Don River to its intersection with Australian Map Grid Line North 5431 000 metres, westerly along that line to its intersection with the Forth River, via that river, the Wilmot River, the River Lea, Lake Lea, the Vale River and the Fury River to its source, to Innes Falls then via the Bluff River and the Murchison River to its source, to the source of the Inkerman River, via that river, the Collingwood River, the Franklin River, the Surprise River to its source, to the source of the Denison River, via that river, the Gordon River, and the Olga River to its source, to the source of the Hardwood River, via that river and the Davey River to the point of commencement.

“ Including also, all islands adjacent to the coast, the King Island Group and the Hunter Group of Islands.

#### “ *Denison*

“ Commencing at the confluence of North-West Bay River with North-West Bay, thence via that river to Wellington Falls, to the source of Montagu Creek, via that creek and Mountain River to its source, to the source of Humphrey Rivulet, via that rivulet to its confluence with the River Derwent, thence via the shoreline to the point of commencement.

*“ Franklin*

“ Commencing at the confluence of the Davey River and the Southern Ocean, thence via that river and the Crossing River to its junction with Dodds River, easterly to the junction of Junction Creek with the Huon River, by that river and the Weld River, to its intersection with the Australian Map Grid Line North 5250 000 metres, easterly along that grid line to its intersection with Mountain River, by that river to its source, to the source of Humphrey Rivulet, by that rivulet to its intersection with H.E.C. transmission line, north-westerly along that line to its intersection with Kundes Creek by that creek to its source, to Mt Faulkner, to the source of Parramore Creek by that creek, the River Derwent, and Hesse Gully to its intersection with the H.E.C. transmission line, south-easterly along that line to the Saddle on Madmans Hill, to the source of Bourbon Creek, by that creek and Duckhole Rivulet to Pitt Water, along the westerly shore of Pitt Water to Pitt Water Bluff, via that coast line to Cape Direction, to Kellys Point, again via the coast line southerly to Tasman Head, to Whale Head, thence westerly and north-westerly along the coast line to point of commencement.

“ Including also, all islands adjacent to the coast, the Maatsuyker Group and Macquarie Island, and excluding the Division of Denison.

*“ Wilmot*

“ Commencing at the confluence of the Tamar River with Bass Strait, thence via that river and Cormiston Creek to its intersection with the H.E.C. transmission line, by that line in a general south-easterly, southerly, south-westerly and easterly direction to its western intersection with Kings Meadows Rivulet, then south-easterly to the source of Jinglers Creek, via that creek and the North Esk River to its source, to Mt Victoria, to the junction of Lottah Road with the Tasman Highway at Little Plain to Murdochs Hill and to the source of Ansons River, via that river to its confluence with the Tasman Sea, southerly along the coast to Pitt Water, thence south-westerly along the Sorell Causeway, again via the coast at Midway Point, continuing along the Sorell Causeway to its junction with the coast, thence north-westerly around the shore of Pitt Water to Duckhole Rivulet, via that rivulet and Bourbon Creek to its source, then to the H.E.C. transmission line at the Saddle on Madmans Hill, north-westerly along that line to its intersection with Hesse Gully via that gully, the River Derwent and Parramore Creek to its source, to Mt Faulkner, to the source of Kundes Creek, via that creek to its intersection with the H.E.C. transmission line, along that line to its intersection with Humphrey Rivulet, via that rivulet to its source, to the source of Mountain River, by that river to its intersection with the Australian Map Grid Line North 5250 000 metres, thence westerly along that grid line to its intersection with the Weld River, by that river and the Huon River to its intersection with Junction Creek, westerly to the junction of Dodds River with the Crossing River, by that river, the Davey River and the Hardwood River to its source, to the source of the Olga River, via that river, the Gordon River and the Denison to its source, to the source of the Surprise River, by that river, the Franklin River, the Collingwood River and the Inkerman River to its source, to the source of the Murchison River,

via that river, and the Bluff River to Innes Falls, to the source of the Fury River, via that river and the Vale River, to Lake Lea, via the River Lea, the Wilmot River and the Forth River to its intersection with Australian Map Grid Line North 5431 000 metres, easterly along that line to its intersection with the Don River, via that river to the Bass Highway, along that highway, Middle Road, William Street and Bluff Road to the coast at Mersey Bluff lighthouse, thence easterly along the coast to the point of commencement.

“Including also, all islands adjacent to the coast, Schouten Island, Maria Island and Tasman Island.”.
