## DAIRY PRODUCTS MARKETING.

## No. 53 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Dairy Products Marketing Act* 1957. [24 October 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,  
as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Dairy Products Marketing Act* 1963.

(2) The *Dairy Products Marketing Act* 1957 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Application  
of quota.

**2** Section ten of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in subsection (4), after the word “convicted”, the words “of an offence”; and
- (b) by omitting from that subsection the words “he has” and substituting therefor the words “, before complaint was made for that offence, he had”.
