ANALYSIS

- 1. Short title, citation, and commencement.
- 2. Power to borrow \$25 000 000 for certain works.

AN ACT to amend the Hobart Marine Board Loan Act 1947.

[23 May 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Hobart Marine Board Loan* Short title, citation, and commencement

(2) The Hobart Marine Board Loan Act 1947, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced when the Principal Act commenced.

Power to borrow \$25 000 000 for certain works. **2** Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting, from subsection (1), the words "not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of \$10 000 000" and substituting therefor the words "but so that the total capital moneys owing at any one time in respect of such borrowing shall not exceed in the whole the sum of \$25 000 000".
